The Book Nook



Building Readers is a resource for families that have concerns about their child's reading skills. Building Readers will assess children using a variety of informal assessments to determine if they require help to become competent readers. For children whose needs fit our broad program, they will begin a six month intervention with tutoring twice weekly. This Building Readers Resource looks very different for each child enrolled. Some children need remediation in phonemic awareness, vowel sounds and how words are sequenced together. Some children need help becoming fluent readers, and others need skills in comprehension.

We meet each child who qualifies at the point of their need and move forward thoughtfully with skill lessons and home practice. We pray with our families. We invite God to be a part of each lesson. We equip our parents to help with home practice and give them an understanding of each assignment. We hold every family accountable in this journey. We provide books for children to read between each session. This journey can be difficult for some children and their families and we try to provide a positive approach noticing each child's strengths as we work on weaknesses.

Story Time

"When this 3rd grade student arrived for his assessment he was extremely quiet & shy. He really couldn't read & didn't understand how vowels were used to make sounds. Even though he knew all the consonants he couldn't blend many consonant-vowel-consonant words together. During our lessons he rarely smiled and was very nervous. One day he told me he'd love to be able to write a story someday. I told him I knew that dream would come true. We prayed every session & asked God to equip us both for the day's tasks. We began with intensive vowel instruction using several modalities. We blended orally, wrote in sand, wrote on paper & we read stories that were at his level. We slowly unlocked the code together. He progressed. But more importantly, this child changed. Confidence started to build & he walked a little taller. He smiled & laughed at the stories he read. He began to share & open up.

He understood how to read & each lesson built him up. He read at home & at Building All Children. He progressed as a reader in a mighty way & is moving toward grade level. And he wrote. I challenged him to write something that was very important to him. We talked about several ideas but he had to select the topic himself. And guess what? His very first story was about a very important day in his life. He wrote about the day he invited Jesus into his heart. We celebrated this piece and it is hanging proudly in our reading area. This child is about to graduate from Building Readers. God has been with us every step of the way, and the joy and gratitude I feel for being a part of this journey fills my heart. I'm going to miss this little guy but I know God has big plans for him."



Rescreens


The Hidden Treasure of BAC

"At Building All Children there's a lot we do that we don't talk about enough, for example rescreens. Every child we assess has the opportunity to complete a rescreen 6 months later. Many parents jump at this opportunity as it gives them a tangible way to see success in their child's development. As a Development Specialist, rescreens are one of my favorite things to do at BAC. I get to see a child, often at their lowest, and then resource and equip the parents for success. Then, 6 months later I see a child who has grown leaps and bounds in all 5 development areas. Lately we have been seeing children who are not making much progress. Because of COVID-19, outside therapies and school services are not what they used to be. It's hard to provide therapy services for children over a computer. But we know that as our community begins to open more, these services will come back in full force. We, at Building All Children, still resource these families as much as we did at their initial assessment because we are always BUILDING." - Kristen Wigner M. Ed., CCPS

Recipes For Building Family Fun

Floam = slime + foam beads

Chalk Paint = 1 part cornstarch + 2 parts water + food coloring

Colored Rice = place uncooked white rice in Ziploc baggie; squirt watercolors, food coloring, or diluted paint onto rice; close baggie and shake rice around until baggie is dry; spread thinly onto cookie sheet or foil & let dry overnight

"Oobleck" = (oobleck is a solid when held and a liquid when released in bowl) mix 2 cups cornstarch + 1 cup water; stir; pour out into a bowl, play, be amazed

Playdough = combine 1 cup all-purpose flour $+ \frac{1}{4}$ cup salt + 2 Tbsp. cream of tartar; in separate bowl combine 1 cup water + 1 Tbsp. vegetable oil + 1 Tbsp. food coloring or liquid watercolors + 10-12 drops essential oils (optional); Add the two mixtures together and stir over medium heat until a ball forms; knead dough on a floured surface until cool and store in airtight container
